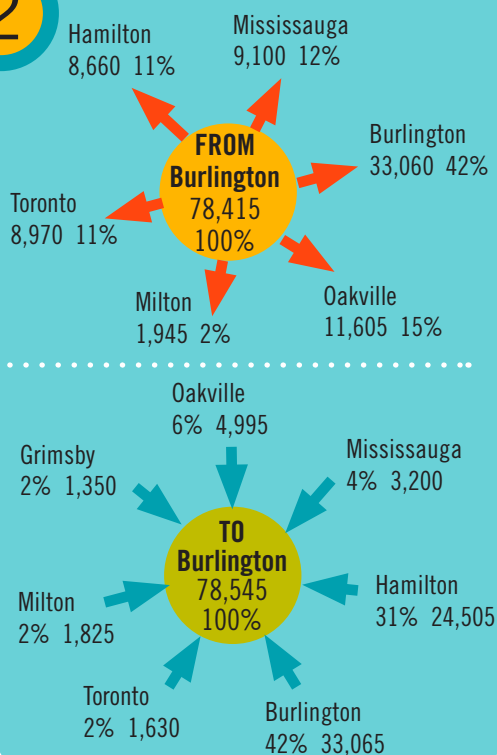

Place of Work and Commuting Patterns by Industry Burlington 2016

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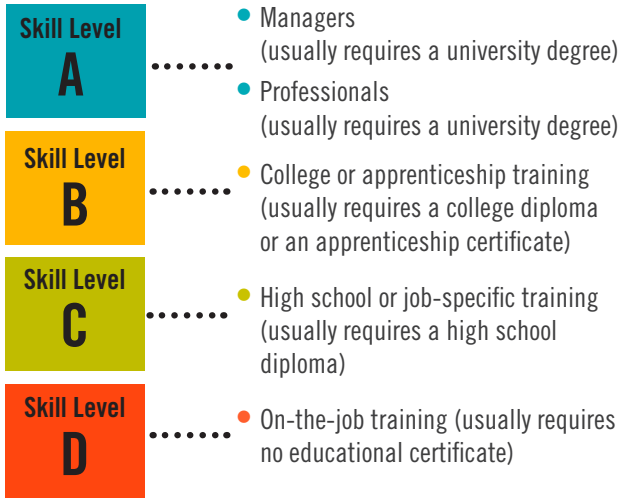

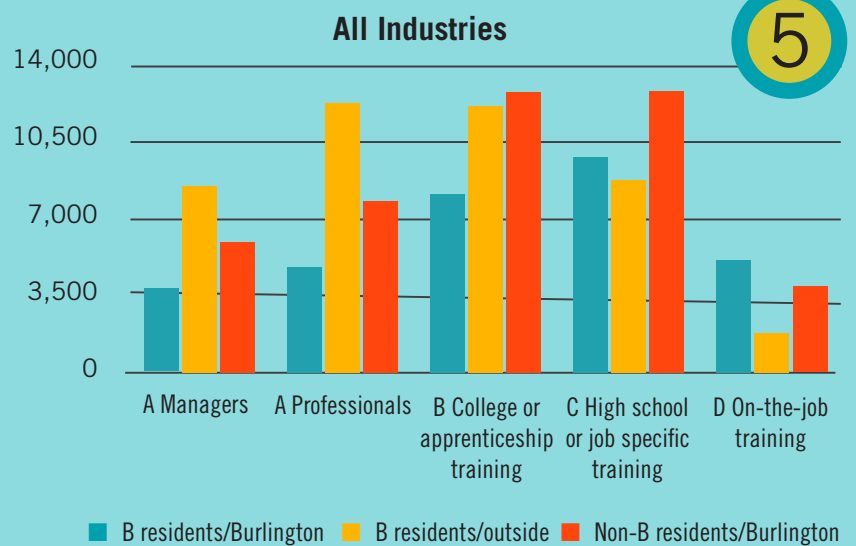

Commuting patterns related to Burlington by skill category, All industries, 2016

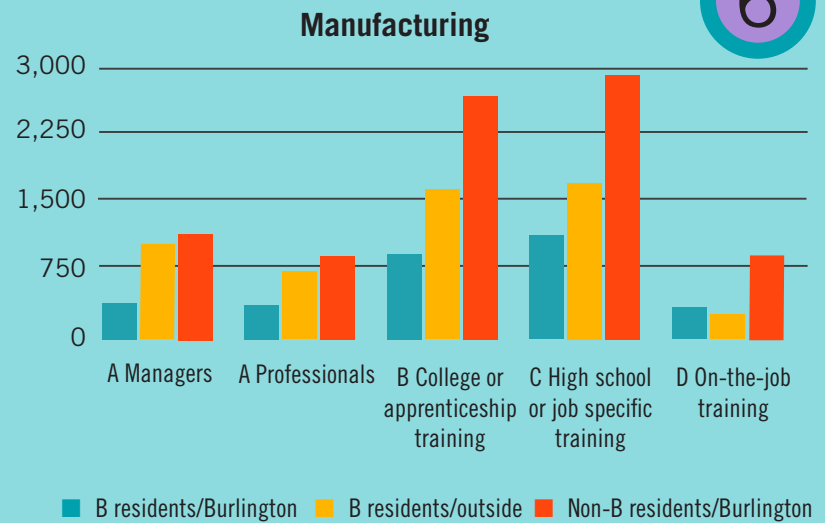

- Non-B residents/Burlington:** Residents living outside Burlington commuting to jobs in Burlington

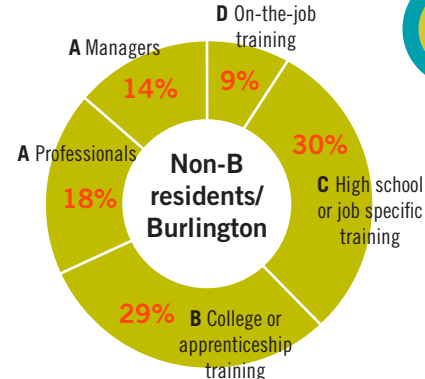
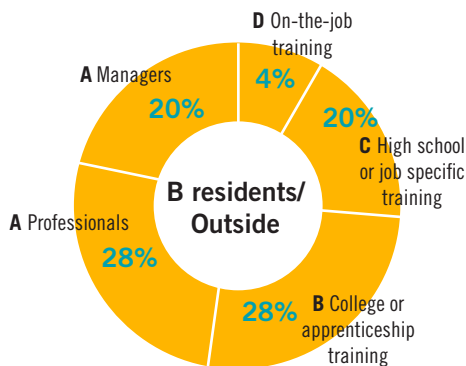
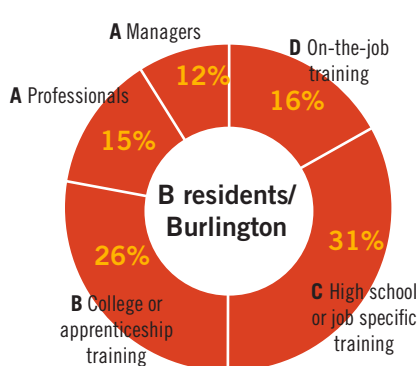


Commuting patterns related to Burlington by skill category, Manufacturing, 2016



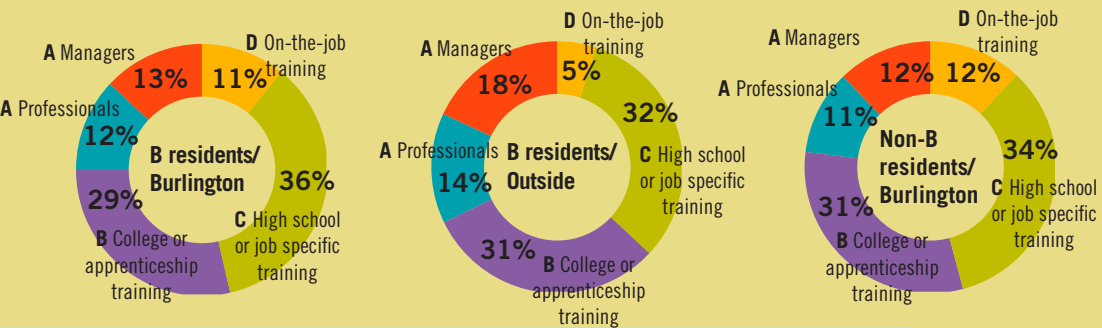
Distribution of skills by Burlington commuting populations

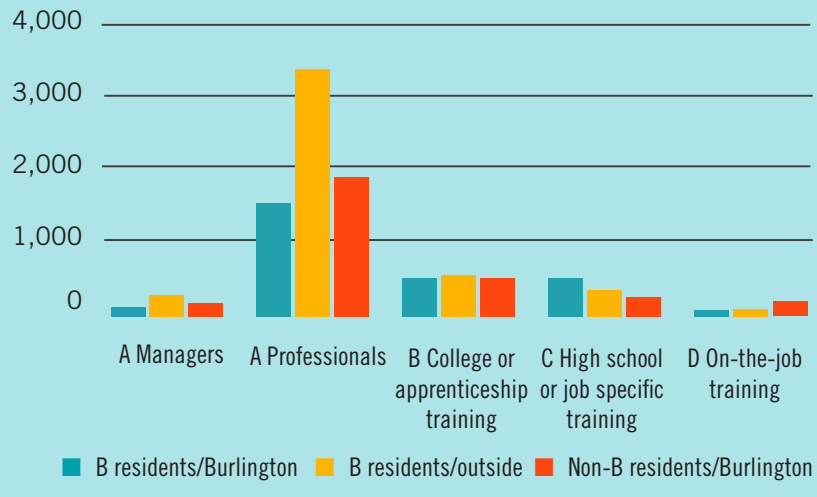

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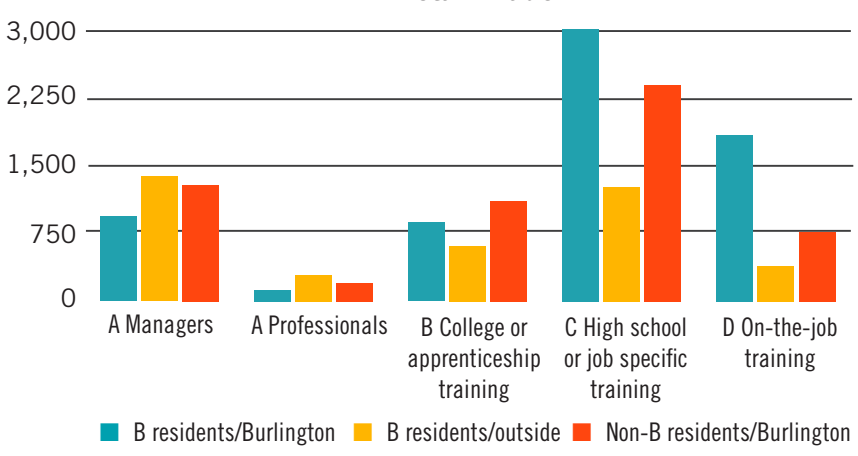

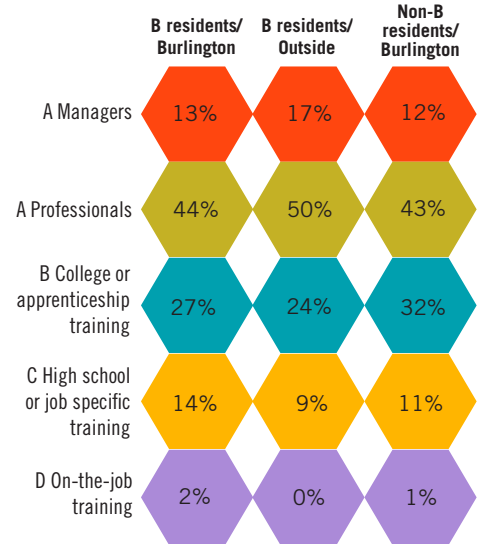
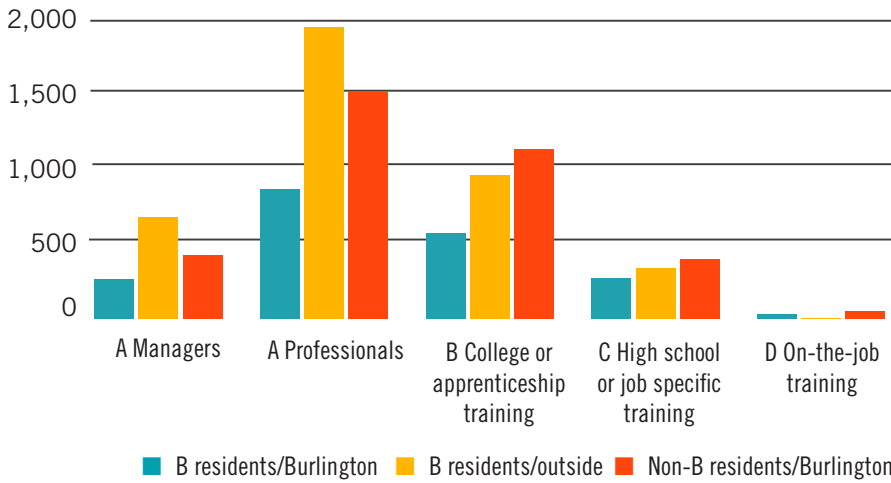
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Distribution of skills by Burlington commuting populations, Professional, scientific and technical services, 2016

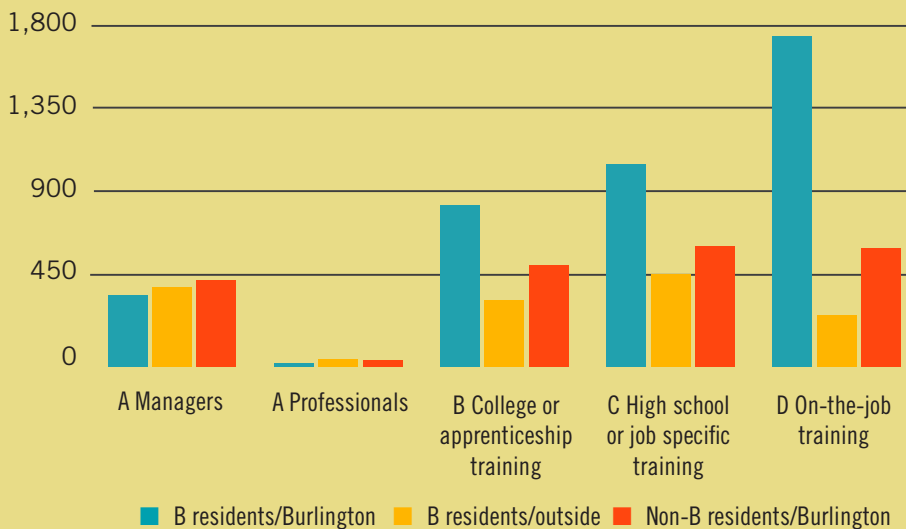

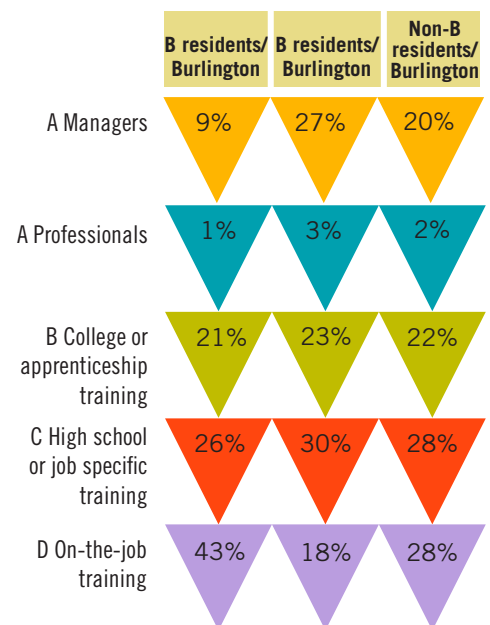
