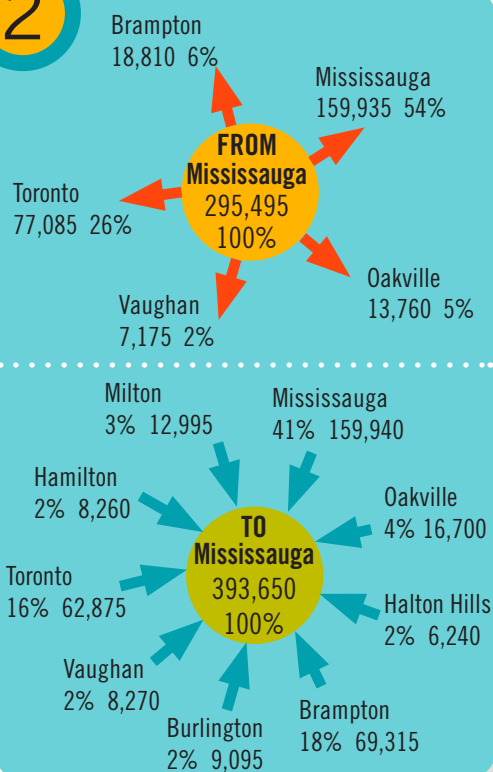

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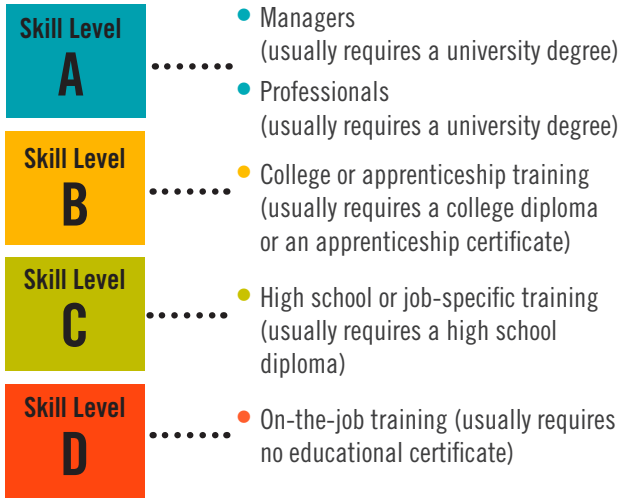

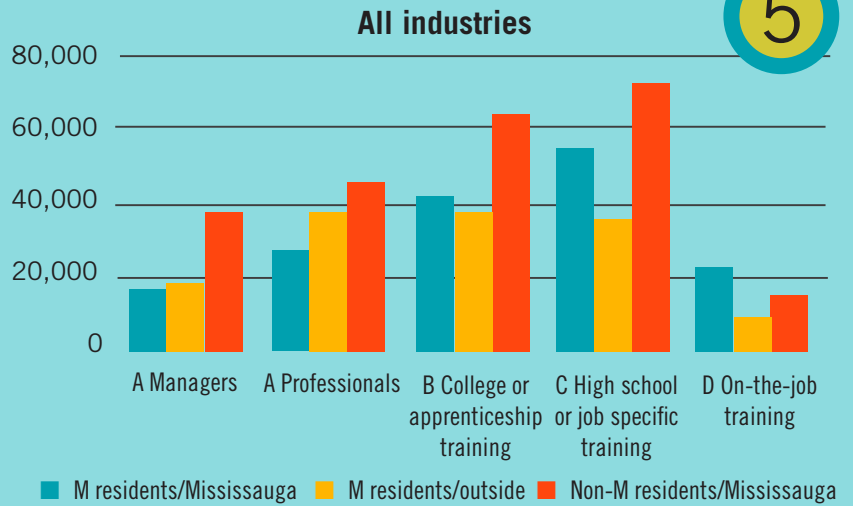

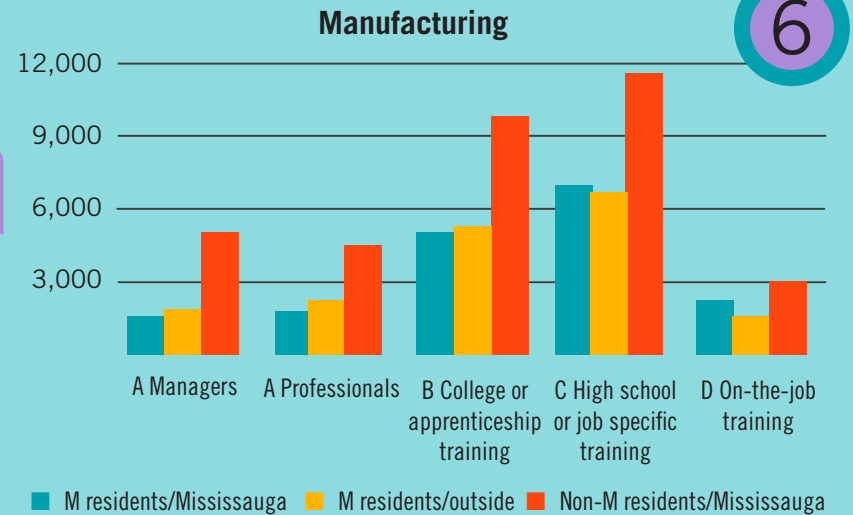
M residents/Mississauga:

Residents living outside Mississauga commuting to jobs in Mississauga

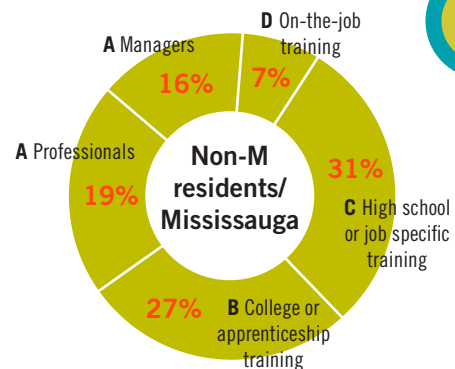
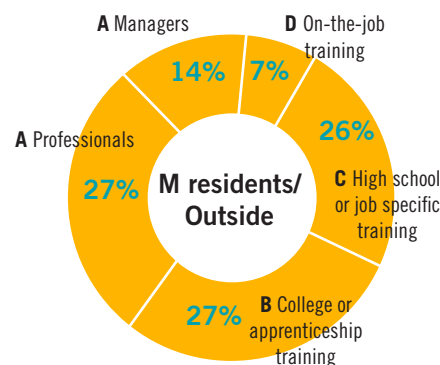
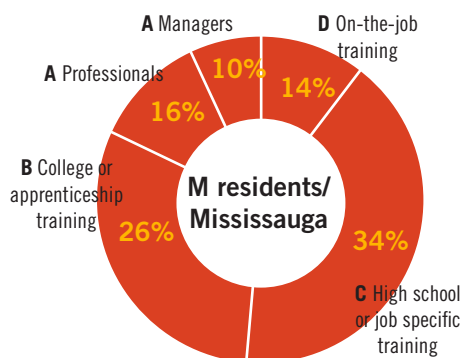


Commuting patterns related to Mississauga by skill category, Manufacturing, 2016

All industries, 2016



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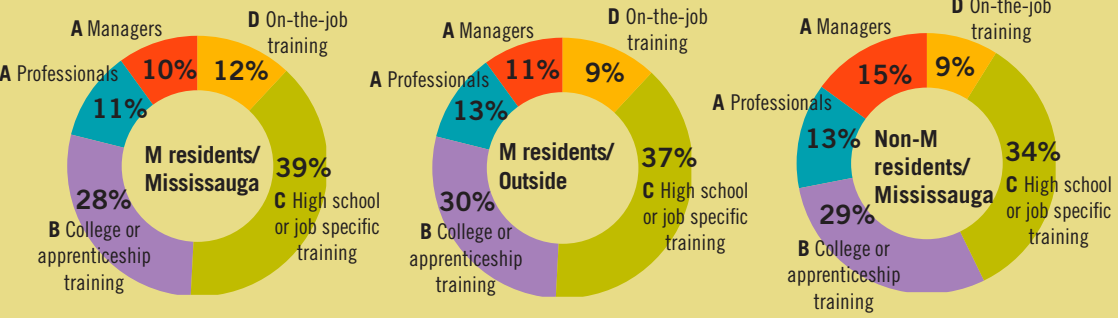


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Distribution of skills by Mississauga commuting populations Manufacturing, 2016

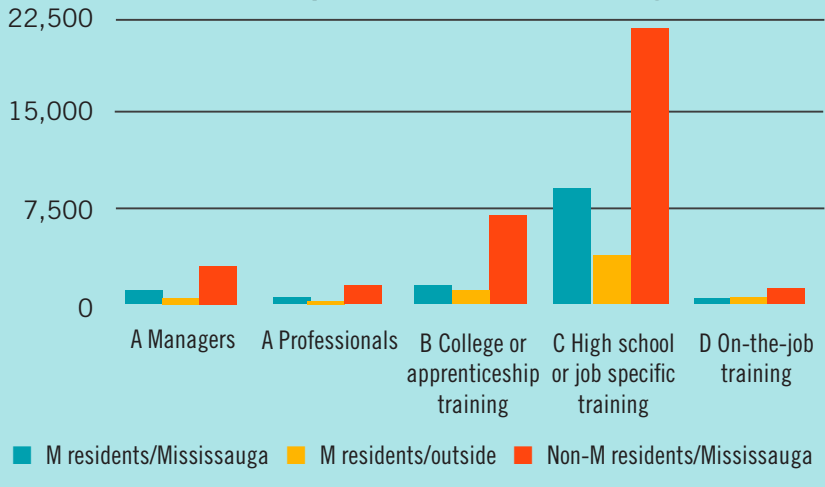

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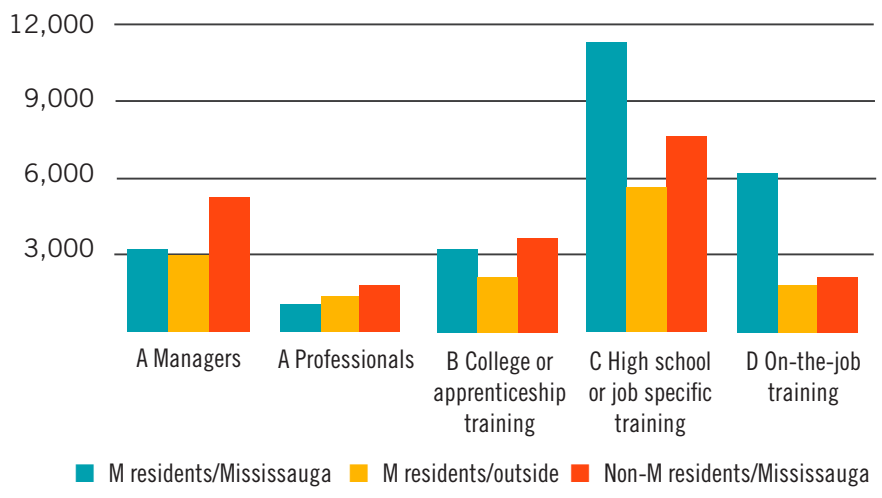

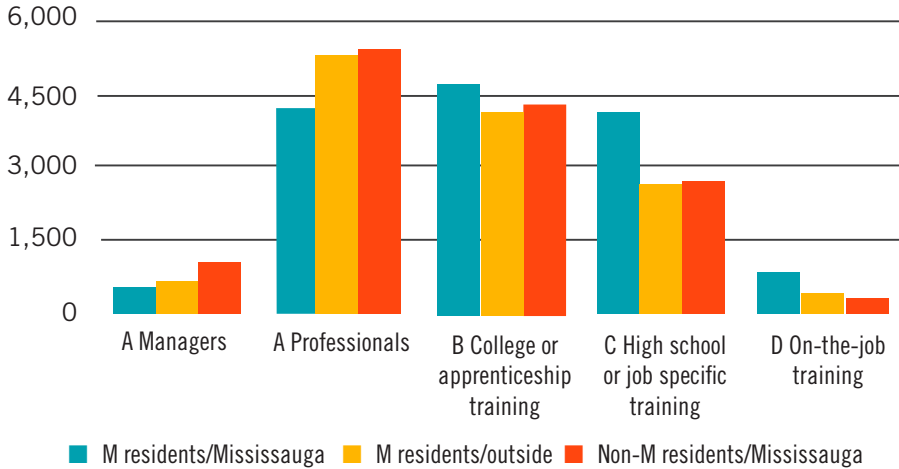

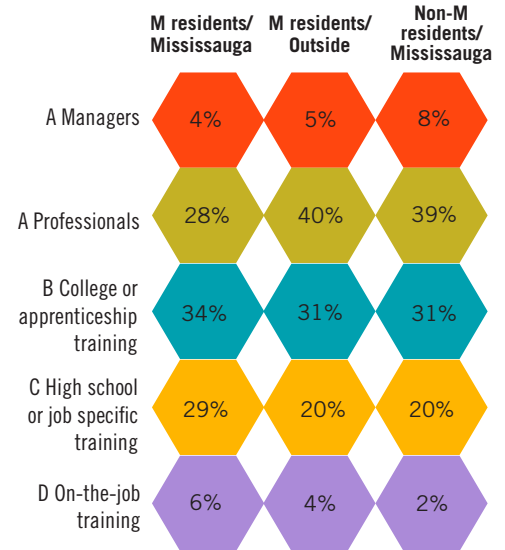

Health Care and Social Assistance



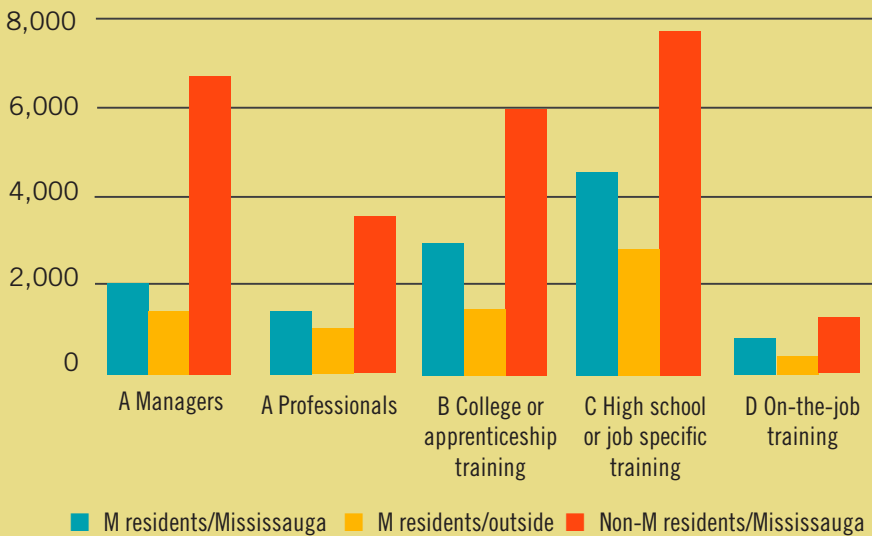
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Distribution of skills by Mississauga commuting populations, Health care and social assistance 2016



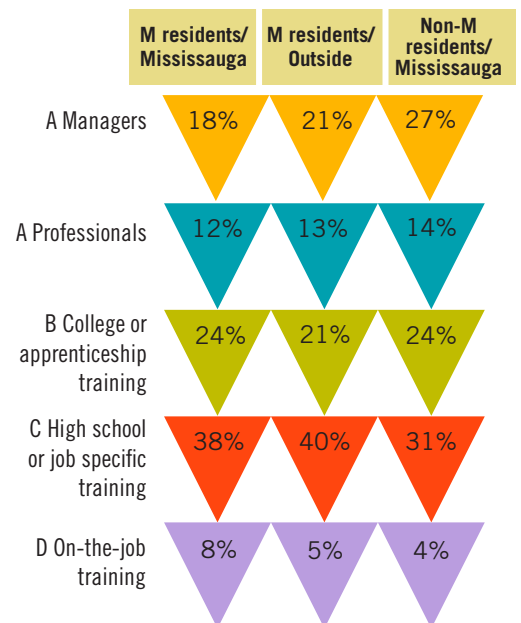
